

China Employment Policy Guidance


Intern in China

- Internship Requirements
- Full-time NYU Shanghai international students or study away students in China for 180+ days

One internship at a time, no longer than 180 days
- Unpaid (transportation & meal allowances allowed)

Relevant to academic major

- Off-Campus Internship Registration
- Students must be verified to work in China. CCD approves and guides students through the legal process, coordinating with Student Mobility and government.



Work in Shanghai

- According to 07 Application for the Notification Letter of Foreigner’s Work Permit and the Foreigner’s Work Permit for Foreign Graduates (Category C), Graduates (having graduated within two years) are eligible to work in:
- Companies registered in 4 Free Trade Zones: Shanghai Pilot FTZ, Zhangjiang Innovation Demonstration Zone, Lingang Special Area, Hongqiao CBD
 - Companies registered in 5 New Towns: Jiading, Qingpu, Songjiang, Fengxian, Nanhui
 - Company listed on Shanghai’s Sci-Tech Innovation Occupation list
