



## **Call for Exhibition Proposals**

NYU Shanghai will host a "Zaanheh Week" from April 13 to 25, 2020. The week will feature, among other things, a group exhibition in the NYU SH Student Gallery located in Room 1250 of the Academic Building. The exhibition will be open to all students, faculty, and staff members of the NYU Shanghai community.

<u>Zaanheh: A Natural History of Shanghai</u> is an interdisciplinary endeavor that explores the history of Shanghai's urban ecology in order to reimagine the future city as it adapts to a changing environment in the era of climate change.

Proposed artwork can be rendered in a variety of forms such as paintings, photographs, video/audio recordings, installations, virtual and/or augmented realities, and performance arts that are related to the ecology, history, and/or future of Shanghai.

## **Guidelines**

- Submit a short (under 500 words) proposal for your work. In it, describe your proposed contribution, and indicate the format of your project (such as painting, installation, media/multimedia, or any other format that is fit for the gallery space) as well as the physical requirements for display in the gallery (e.g. size and installation plans).
- Attach to the proposal your resumé or artistic portfolio.
- The selection committee reserves the right to modify the submitted artwork.
