Career Development Center Service Policies

When students use the services provided by the NYU Shanghai Career Development Center, they must adhere to the following guidelines. Violations of these guidelines will remain on student records.

When participating in NYU Shanghai CDC on-campus events, using its services and joining its off-campus programs, I agree to the following:

- All information found on my resume, unofficial transcript and Handshake profile and other social media platforms is up-to-date, truthful, and accurate.
- I will not share my login information with other individuals from NYU Shanghai and its peer institutions.
- I give permission to the NYU Shanghai Career Development Center to provide my resume and other job search documents to prospective employers.
- I will honor all commitments. When I RSVP for events, I understand that I am making a commitment to attend. If I cannot attend, I will cancel my reservation prior to the event, so that a peer can replace me.
- I will exercise professional conduct during all career development and recruitment related activities, including interactions with NYU Shanghai Career Development Center staff.
- I will notify employers of acceptance or nonacceptance of internships or full-time offers in a timely manner, either verbally or in writing.
- If I renege on a verbal or written offer, my Dean will be contacted and accept any resulting consequences.
- Jobs listed in Handshake may not be shared with another recruiting entity or posted to another job site.

I accept that failure to adhere to any of the above points may result in the removal of my NYU Shanghai Career Development Center privileges, including access to Handshake, On-campus Recruiting jobs, career fairs, and career counseling appointments.
