

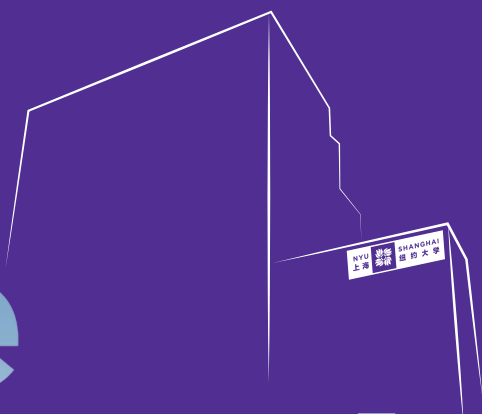

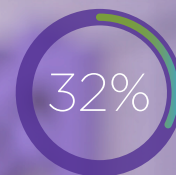

## Distribution of Majors



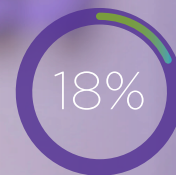

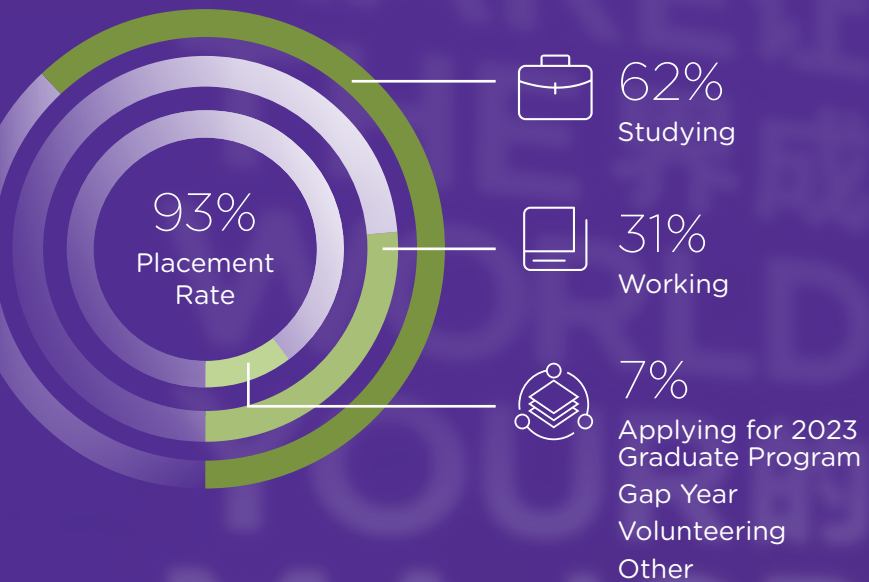

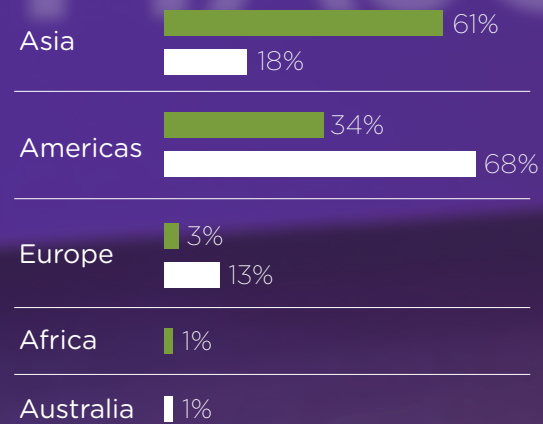

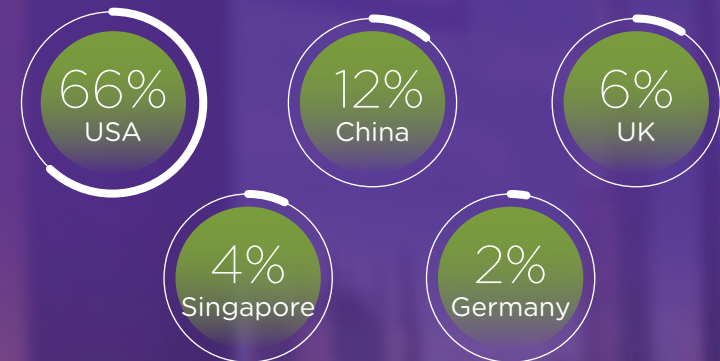
### ■ Home Regions vs. ■ Post-graduation Regions

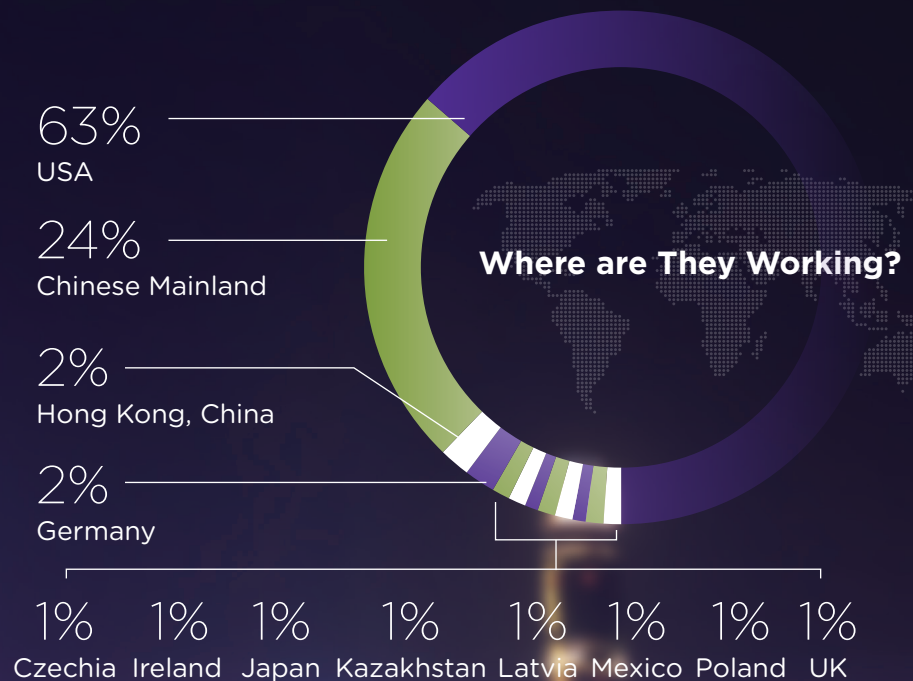
## By Industry



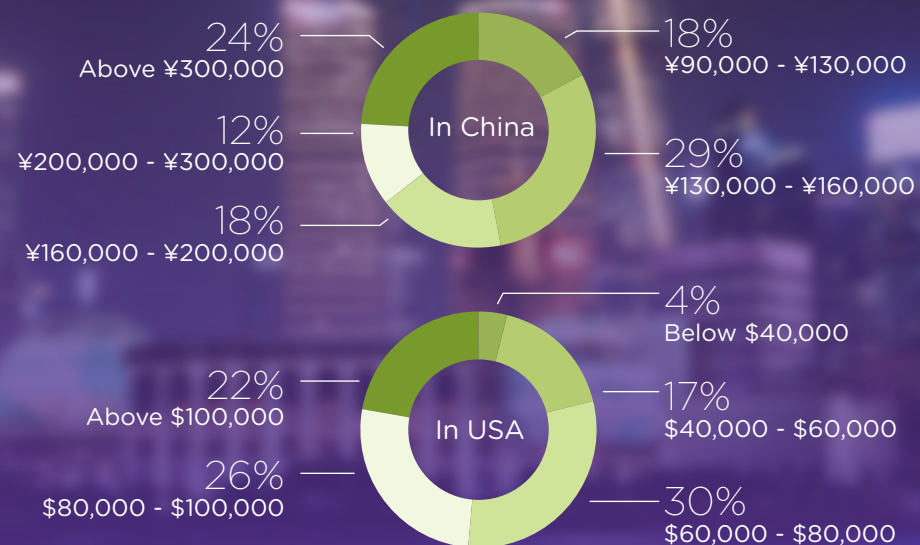

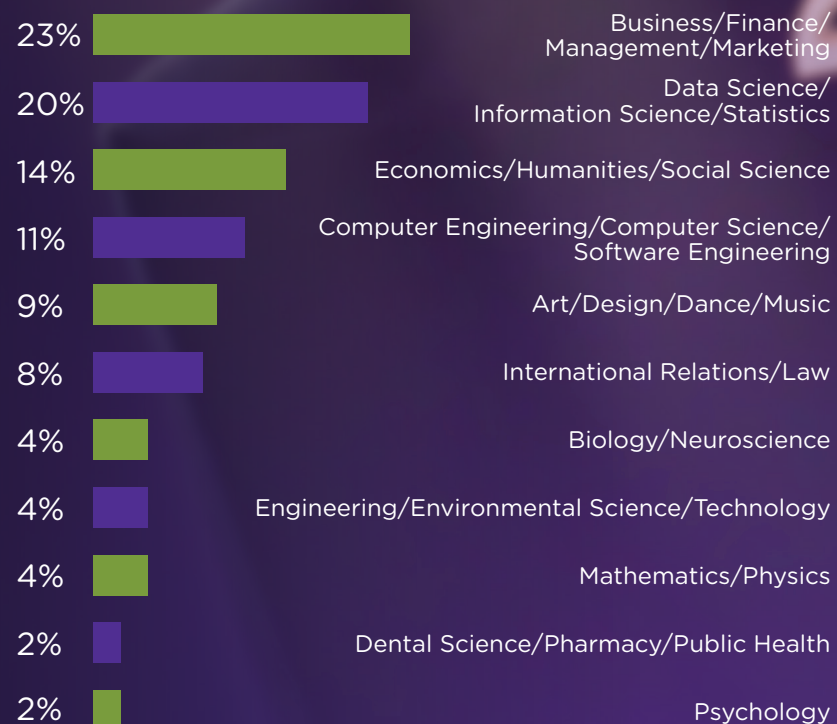

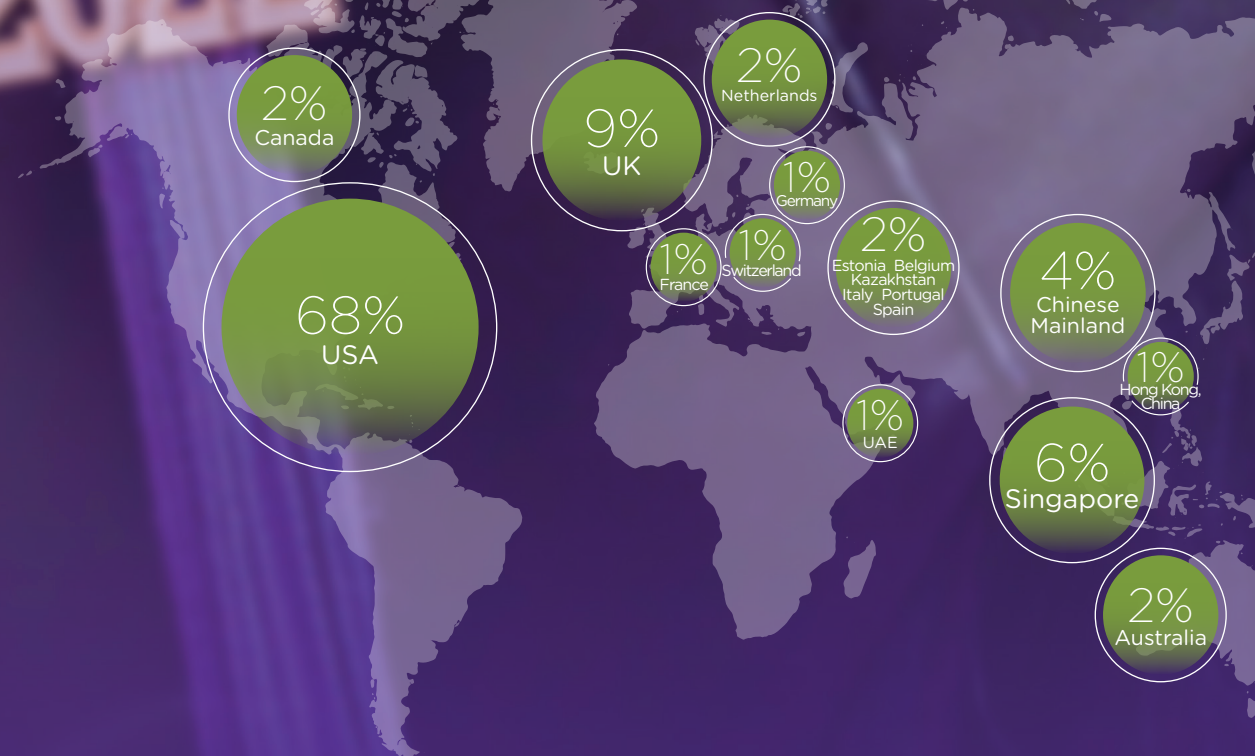
