You will likely tick boxes in several columns because proficiency varies depending on the skill. To select an SPS course(s), focus on the one or two levels with the most ticks (\checkmark).

Guidelines - For language learners who have not used English in a long time, please select courses at the Elementary level. For experienced language learners and people who use English on a regular basis, please select courses at the Intermediate level. For very experienced language learners or people who use English on a daily basis, you can select courses at the Intermediate or Advanced level.
