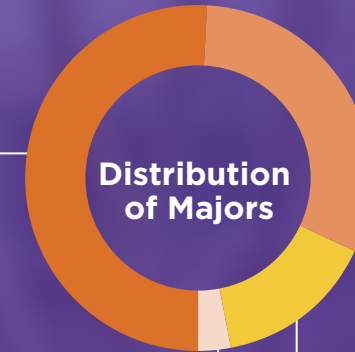

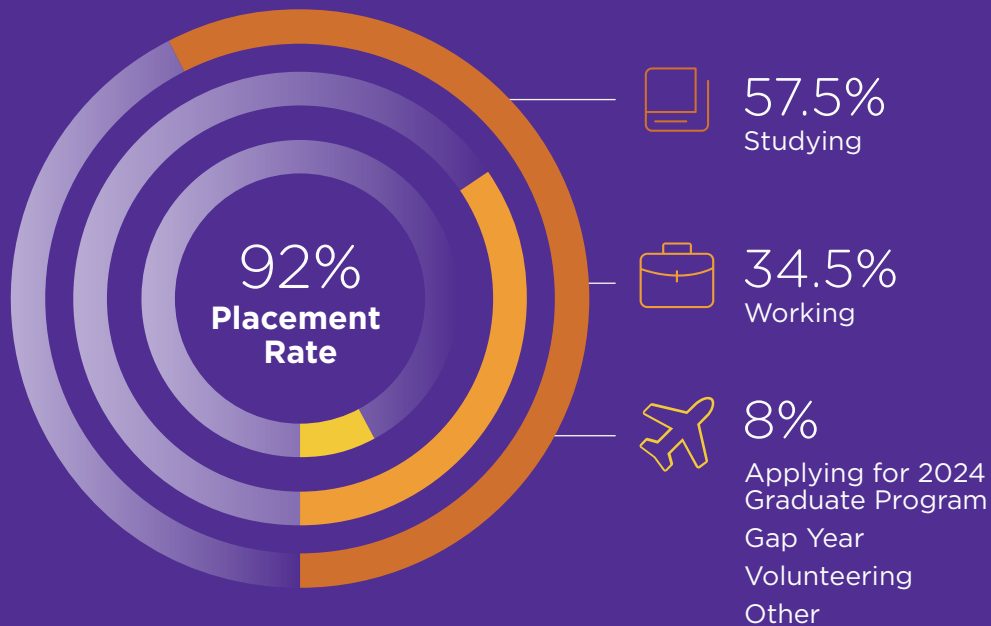

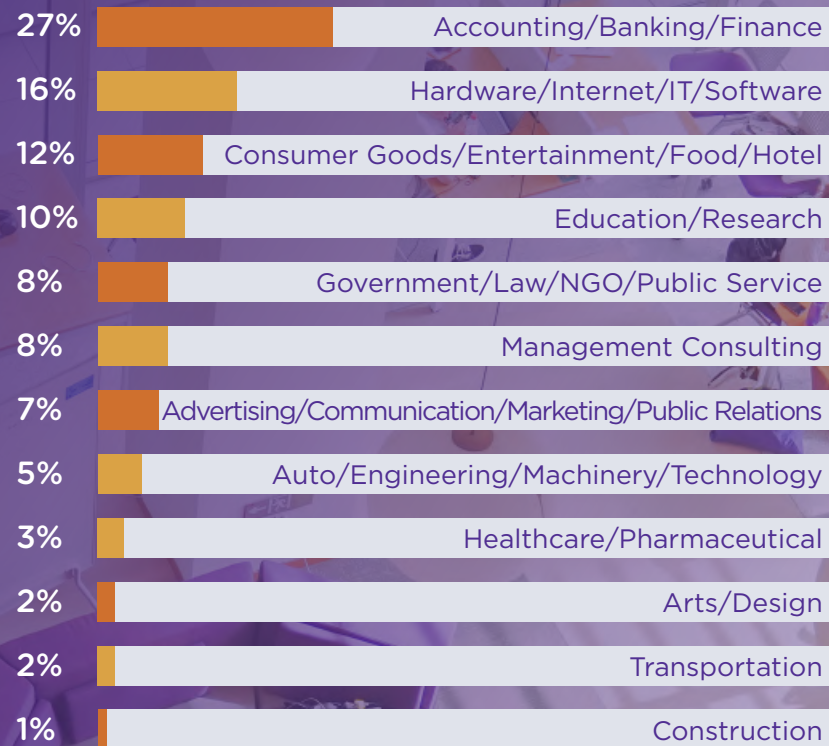
Where is the Class of 2023?

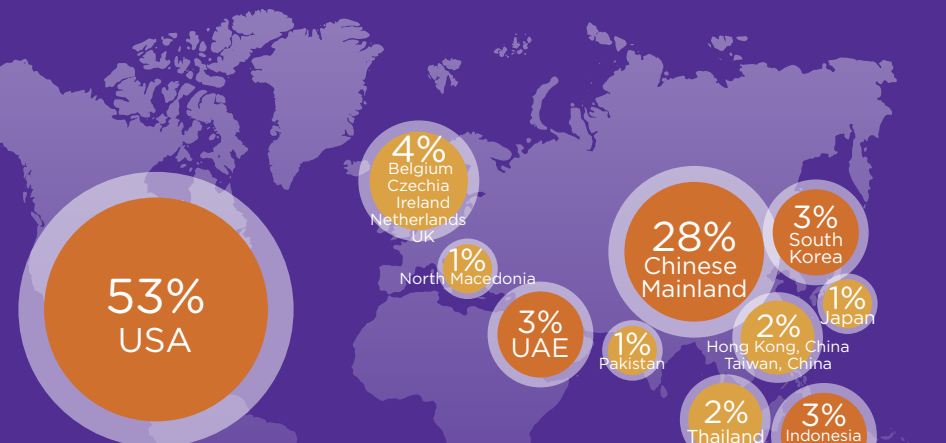

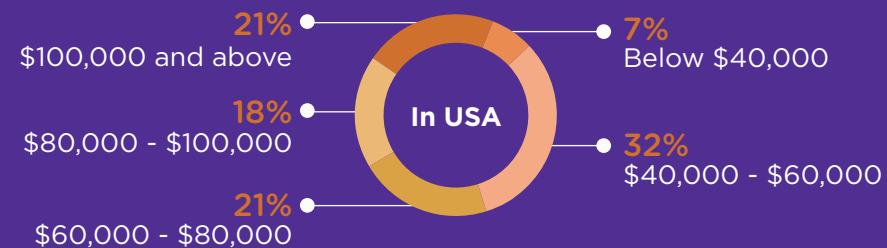
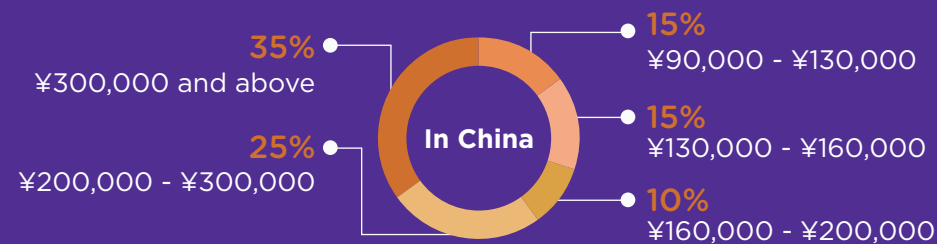
