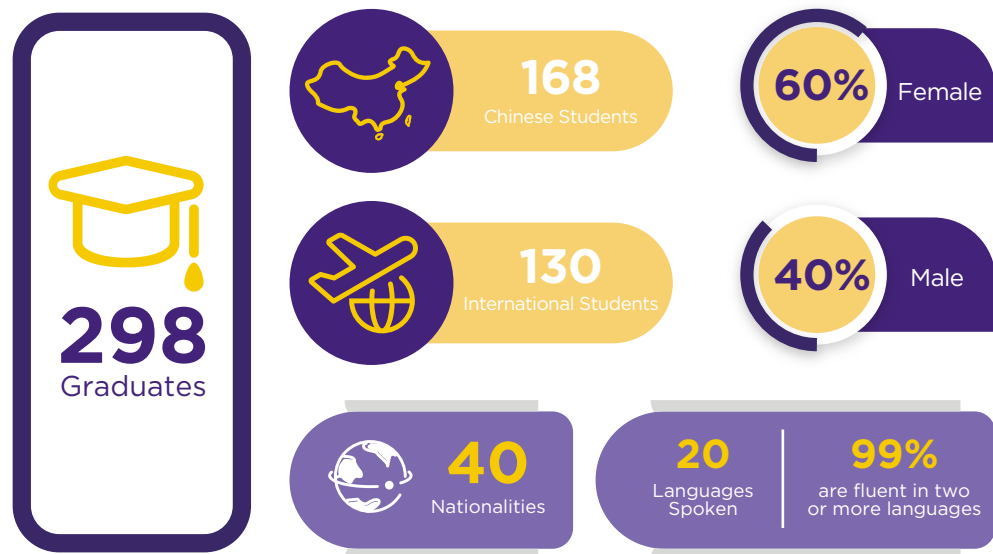

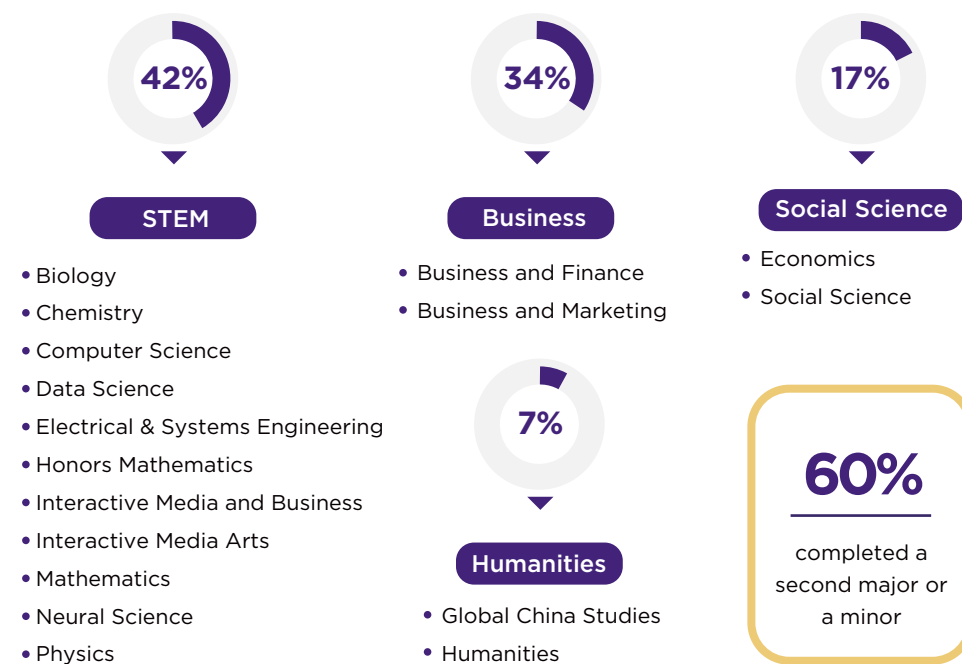
CLASS PROFILE

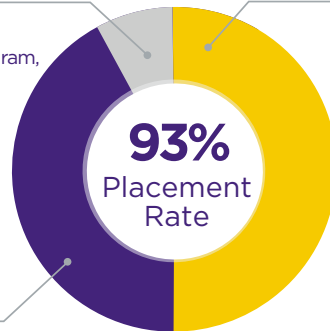

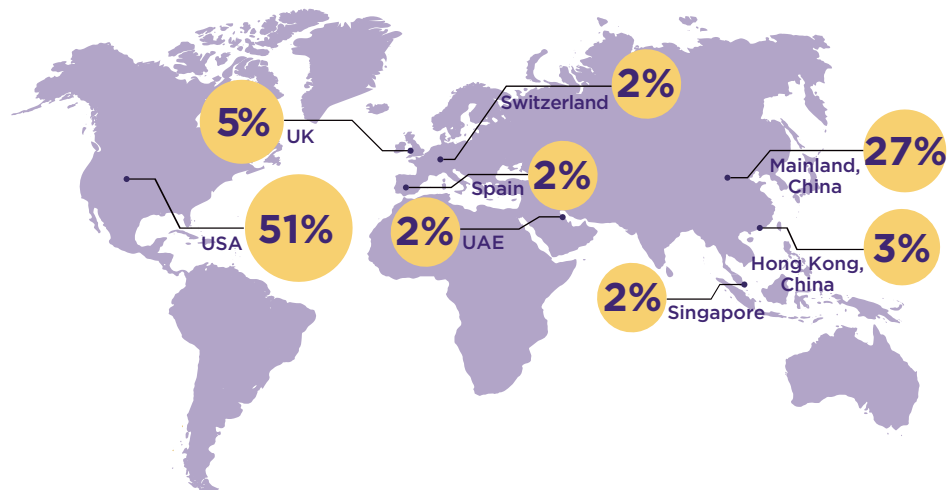

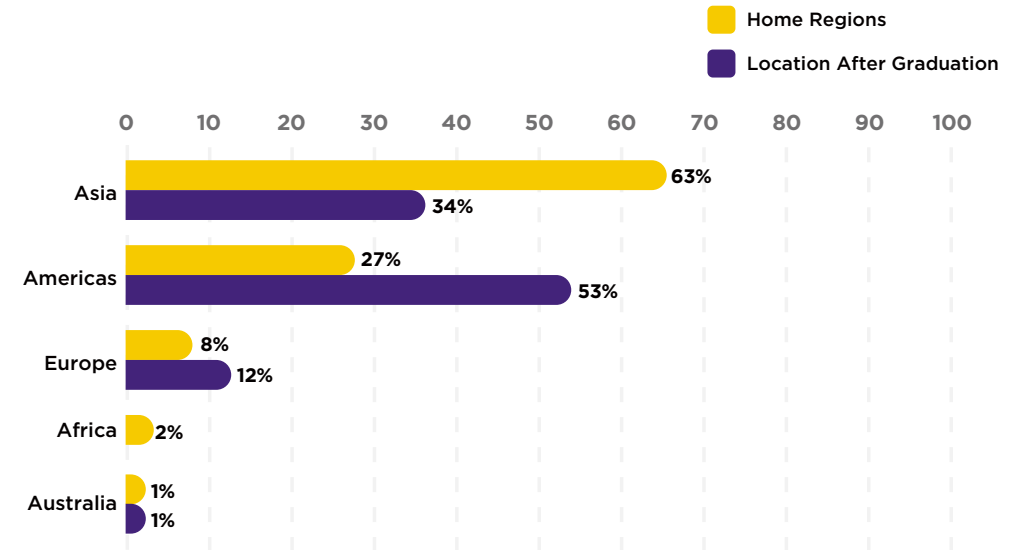
Where is the Class of 2021?

Home Regions vs. Location After Graduation



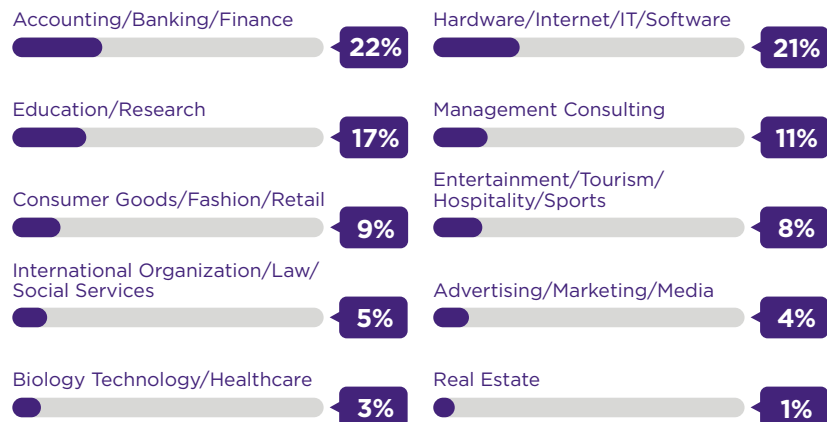

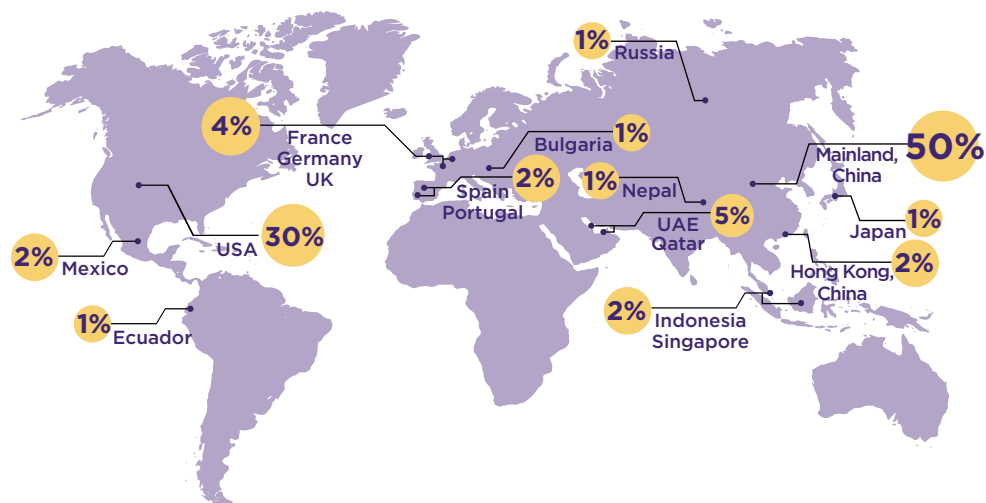

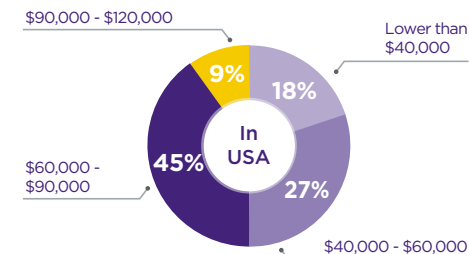
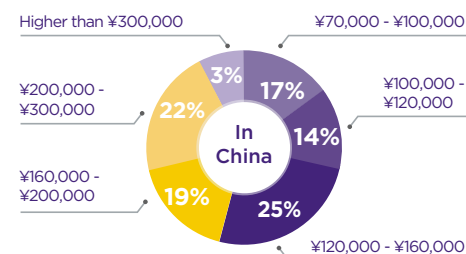
