All NYU Alumni are welcome to use the NYU Shanghai Library. Alumni can use all print and electronic resources when inside the library but do not have borrowing privileges. Given the size of our space and collection, we can accommodate a maximum of 10 alumni each day. Access is on a first come first served basis.

In addition to onsite privileges, alumni also have free, online access to a package of premium electronic resources, such as ProQuest and JSTOR, thanks to a gift from the Class of 2006 and donations from Friends of Bobst Library. To use these resources, please visit http://www.alumni.nyu.edu/.

Alumni should use the North Entrance on Songlin Road to enter the building. Paper or electronic NYU Alumni Card along with Chinese National ID, Passport or Driver's License are required to access the library. Please inform the building receptionist that you are visiting the library as an alumnus/a. Please note that your visit is restricted at the 4F library area during the <u>library services hours</u>.
