Orientations

Graduate and Advanced Education Faculty

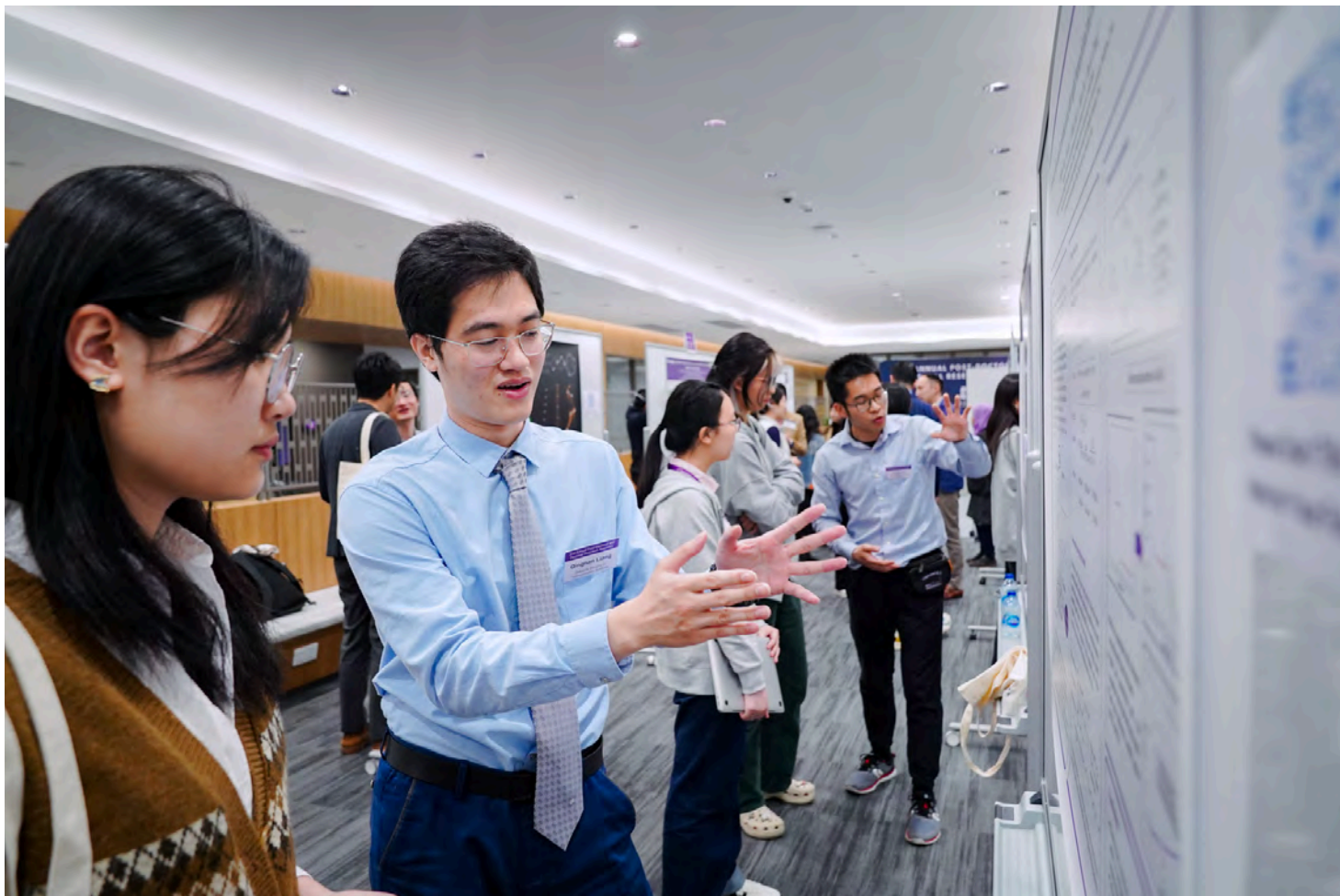
Between Summer 2023 and Summer 2024, 47 faculty members at NYU Shanghai taught graduate courses across various disciplines, contributing to the university's dynamic academic environment. Courses included: Human Behavior in the Social Environment, Second Language Acquisition, Volatility Modeling, Network Analytics, Chinese Financial Markets, Pricing, Art with AI, Campaign Strategy, Data Visualization, and many others.



Experiential Learning

Experiential learning is a signature feature of NYU Shanghai master’s programs. Students from the NYU Shanghai - NYU Stern MS program visited Cadillac’s Shanghai Factory & Experience Center in September 2023. Led by MS in Marketing and Retail Science (MRS) Capstone Director, Professor Rayn Wang, the visit featured collaborative activities that bridged theory and industry practice.

NYU Shanghai - NYU Stern currently offers four MS programs: MS in Quantitative Finance, MS in Data Analytics and Business Computing, MS in Marketing and Retail Science, and MS in Organization Management and Strategy.



Postdoctoral and Doctoral Research Assembly

NYU Shanghai's 2nd Annual Postdoctoral and Doctoral Research Assembly showcased the innovative research of two postdoctoral fellows and 18 PhD students across disciplines like biology, computer science, sociology, and urban studies. Best Oral Presentation and Audience Favorite Poster awards recognized outstanding work.

2024 NYU Annual Conference on Global Real Estate and Capital Markets at NYU Shanghai

The 2024 NYU Annual Conference on Global Real Estate and Capital Markets at NYU Shanghai brought together nearly 200 attendees, including over 30 senior thought leaders from academia and industry, at the university's New Bund campus. The event featured discussions on real estate equity investment, REITs, and China's evolving markets, as well as the official launch of the newly founded NYU Institute for Cities and Real Estate in Emerging Markets at NYU Shanghai (ICREEM).



IMA Low Res Thesis '24 Show

The Interactive Media Arts Low Residency (IMA Low Res) Master’s Program, jointly offered by NYU Tisch School of the Arts and NYU Shanghai, hosted its “Thesis ’24 Show” in June 2024 at the NYU Shanghai New Bund Campus. The show featured innovative and immersive projects by the Class of 2024 from seven countries, highlighting students’ technical skills, artistic vision, and personal insights. The two-day show attracted NYU alumni, broader university community as well as professionals from the design, art, and technology fields.



TESOL Inter-Institutional Training Programs

Professor John Liang, Program Director of NYU Shanghai - NYU Steinhardt's joint MA in TESOL, led professional training sessions as part of a collaborative initiative with the Shanghai Foreign Language Education Press Training Center. Trainings focused on content-based course design, equipping educators with effective strategies to integrate content and language instruction.



PELC Certificate Program

NYU Shanghai's Master of Social Work program, in partnership with the NYU Silver School of Social Work, offered the Palliative and End-of-Life Care (PELC) Certificate Program from July through August 2024. The 45-hour hybrid course blended Eastern and Western knowledge and practices, while combining clinical expertise, theories, and leadership development.

NYU Shanghai - NYU Silver's Master of Social Work program consists of one year of study in China followed by one year of study in the United States.



First-Year Doctoral Summer Camp

Newly admitted Fall 2024 NYU Shanghai PhD students participated in the second annual First-Year Doctoral Summer Camp in July 2024, joining peers from other NYU schools. Through a variety of planned activities, these new doctoral students forged early social connections, built interdisciplinary networks, explored NYU’s global resources, and positioned themselves well for their academic journey in New York.

NYU Shanghai offers opportunities for PhD study and research in 11 disciplines: Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Data Science, Electrical Engineering, Mathematics, Neural Science, Physics, Sociology, and Transportation Systems, and Public Administration.
